

**RESOLUTION NO. 24-09-100**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF ISLAMORADA, VILLAGE OF ISLANDS, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 24-07-64; ADOPTING A TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2024 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2025, PURSUANT TO SECTION 200.065, FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, the Village Council of Islamorada, Village of Islands, Florida (the "Village"), determined a proposed millage rate for Fiscal Year 2024-2025, as set forth in Resolution No. 24-07-64 adopted on July 9, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, the provisions of Section 200.065(2)(c), Florida Statutes, require that a municipality re-compute the proposed millage rate and adopt a tentative millage rate within eighty (80) days of certification of taxable value; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council held a public hearing on September 5, 2024 to consider any adjustment of its proposed millage levy and to consider an operating budget for the Fiscal Year 2024-2025, beginning October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025 ("FY 24-25"), in accordance with the provisions of Section 200.065, Florida Statutes.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF ISLAMORADA, VILLAGE OF ISLANDS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.**    **Recitals.** The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.

**Section 2.**    **Adopting a Tentative Millage Rate.** The Village Council of Islamorada, Village of Islands, hereby resolves that the proposed millage rate on all taxable assessed property value for Fiscal Year 2024-2025 as set forth in Resolution No. 24-07-64 is hereby recomputed and

tentatively established at 2.800 mills, which represents \$2.80 for each thousand dollars of taxable assessed property value (for the tax year commencing from and after January 1, 2024); and that the tentative millage rate of 2.800 represents a 10.69% increase or .2703 mills above the rolled-back rate, which is 2.5297.


**Section 3.**    **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
