

**A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF ISLAMORADA,  
VILLAGE OF ISLANDS, FLORIDA, APPROVING A  
MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE FLORIDA  
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) AND  
ISLAMORADA, VILLAGE OF ISLANDS, FOR THE KEYS  
CONNECTING OVERSEAS TO ADVANCE SAFE TRAVEL (KEYS  
COAST) CONNECTED VEHICLE PILOT PROJECT; AUTHORIZING  
VILLAGE OFFICIALS TO IMPLEMENT THE TERMS AND  
CONDITIONS OF THE MOA; AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE  
MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE MOA; AND PROVIDING FOR AN  
EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, Islamorada, Village of Islands (the "Village") since 2021 the Village has participated in the Connected Vehicles Pilot Program with Florida Department of Transportation for the Keys Connecting Overseas to Advance Safe Travel ("Keys COAST") project; and

**WHEREAS**, Keys COAST is an FDOT-led connected vehicle pilot program implemented on US 1 (SR 5) within the Florida Keys; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to this pilot project, FDOT intended to install Roadside Units (RSUs) at signalized intersections along approximately 112 miles of US 1 from Key Largo to Key West and at other select locations; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to this pilot project, FDOT intended to install On-Board Units (OBUs) on test vehicles including and not limited to freight, transit, emergency, and agency fleet vehicles (Test Vehicles); and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to this pilot project, FDOT intended to upgrade the existing traffic signal system to include Automated Traffic Signal Performance Measures (ATSPM) and implement Security Credential Management System (SCMS); and

**WHEREAS**, the connected vehicle (CV) infrastructure and devices installed on state roads pursuant to this pilot project have become part of FDOT's overall traffic management and traffic signal system; and

**WHEREAS**, on or about February 4, 2021, the Village approved Resolution 21-02-12, approving a Memorandum of Agreement ("Original MOA") between the Village and FDOT authorizing the Village's participation in the project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village was recently advised by FDOT of the expiration of the Original MOA and FDOT's desire to continue the program with the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, FDOT has presented the Village with a new Memorandum of Agreement ("2025 MOA") to participate in the project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council finds that the Village's participation in the project and approval of the 2025 MOA between FDOT and the Village are in the best interest of the Village.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF ISLAMORADA, VILLAGE OF ISLANDS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Recitals.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

**Section 2. Approval of Memorandum of Agreement.** The Village Council hereby approves the 2025 MOA between FDOT and the Village to participate in the Keys COAST project, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit "A," together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the Village Manager and approved as to form and legality by the Village Attorney.

**Section 3. Authorization.** The Village Manager and/or his designee and the Village Attorney are hereby authorized to take all steps necessary to implement the terms and conditions of the 2025 MOA.

**Section 4. Execution of Agreement.** The Village Manager is authorized to execute the 2025 MOA on behalf of the Village, to execute any required agreements and/or documents to implement the terms and conditions of the 2025 MOA subject to the approval as to form and legality by the Village Attorney.

**Section 5. Effective Date.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.




