

## **RESOLUTION NO. 25-10-98**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF ISLAMORADA, VILLAGE OF ISLANDS, FLORIDA, APPROVING A CHANGE ORDER TO THE EXISTING REMOTE MONITORING AND MANAGEMENT CONTRACT WITH UNITED DATA TECHNOLOGIES TO COVER ALL VILLAGE FACILITIES; AUTHORIZING AN ADDITIONAL NOT-TO-EXCEED FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025–26; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION OF VILLAGE OFFICIALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, in 2015, the Village Council adopted Resolutions 15-09-89 and 15-11-111 approving the selection of United Data Technologies ("UDT") and authorizing a continuing services agreement for IT consulting and support services, including network monitoring; and

**WHEREAS**, On December 12, 2023, the Village Council adopted Resolution 23-12-141 authorizing United Data Technologies ("UDT") to provide Remote Monitoring and Management ("RMM") of network equipment across multiple Village facilities under a three-year contract, at an annual cost of \$25,800, with additional Time-and-Materials ("T&M") charges for work outside the scope of services; and

**WHEREAS**, during the 2024–25 fiscal year, Wastewater operations required the installation of security cameras and access control systems at pump stations to meet compliance requirements, and the Village's co-location facility was relocated, requiring additional setup and configuration to integrate with the existing network; and

**WHEREAS**, for Fiscal Year 2025–26, the Network Engineer position has been defunded, requiring greater reliance on vendor-provided services to ensure continuity of network operations and cybersecurity readiness; and

**WHEREAS**, the Network Engineer position previously cost the Village close to \$200,000 annually in salary and benefits, while the expanded RMM contract with UDT and T&M

authorization total \$80,693.64, resulting in annual savings of more than \$100,000 to the Village;  
and

**WHEREAS**, sufficient funds are available in the Fiscal Year 2025–26 General Fund Professional Services account to cover the total not-to-exceed authorization of \$80,693.64; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council finds it in the best interest of the Village to approve this change order with UDT and authorize the necessary expenditures.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF ISLAMORADA, VILLAGE OF ISLANDS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.**     **Recitals.**     The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.

**Section 2.**     **Approve the Change Order.** The Village Council hereby approves a change order and additional not-to-exceed to the RMM contract with UDT to expand coverage to all Village facilities.

**Section 3.**     **Authorization of Village Officials.** Notwithstanding the limitations imposed upon the Village Manager pursuant to the Village’s Purchasing Procedures Ordinance, the Village Manager is authorized to expend budgeted funds for the Services and to present budget amendments to the Village Council as necessary and appropriate

**Section 4.**     **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


